


A water-soluble corticoid given as a rectal infusion has produced complete symptomatic relief and considerable improvement, as judged by sigmoidoscopic and histological findings,' in a high proportion of patients with ulcerative colitis. This technique has now been further simplified by presenting a small quantity of Predsol (water-soluble prednisolone) in solution as an enema to avoid the inconvenience of prolonged administration by rectal drip.
