How much Caved-S can an intractable duodenal ulcer patient take?



For a full year without relapse, 12 tablets a day for up to 16 weeks*

* This dosage regimen was established in a recent trial of Caved-S on patients all with intractable duodenal ulcer and a history of more than six relapses in the year prior to the trial. Of twenty patients receiving 12 Caved-S tablets a day for 16 weeks, 12 had no relapse in a full year's follow-up, and the other 8 had two or one relapse in the follow-up year.
