Strength of recommendation

- 1: Strong; "We recommend"
- 2: Weak; "We suggest"

Quality of evidence

- A: High (based on multiple well-designed and conducted trials or meta-analyses on applicable populations)
- B: Moderate (based on a single trial or multiple trials with minor limitations, or consistent findings from multiple observational studies)
- C: Low (based on single or few observations studies or multiple studies with inconsistent findings or major limitations)
- D: Very low (based on expert opinion, case reports, reasoning from first principles)
